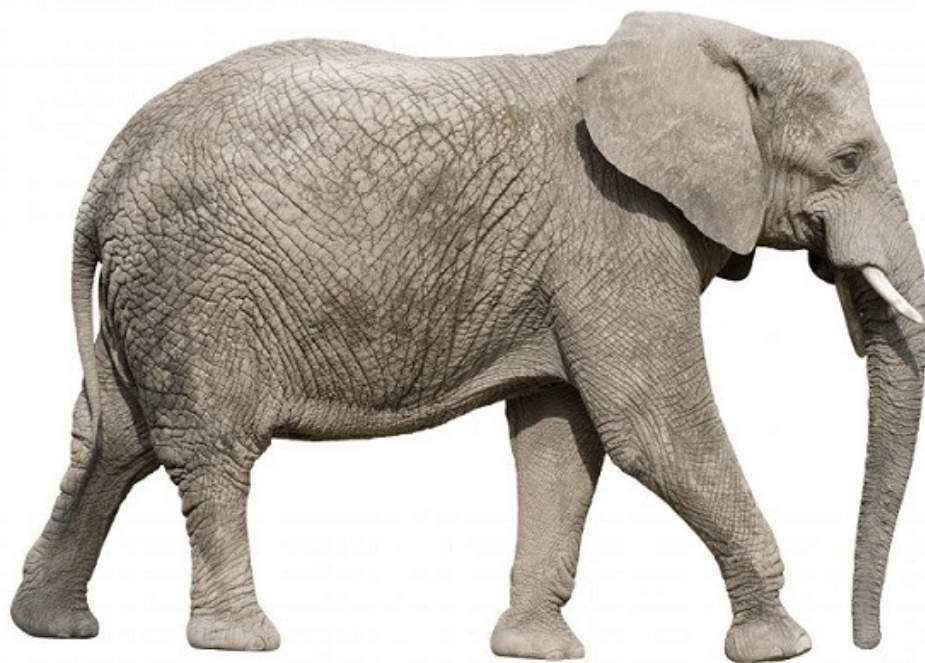


Take this quiz! Win an elephant! *
